(NTUST) Regulations for Judging and Selection of

Special Topics on Industrial Management

Article 1 These judging and selection guidelines (hereafter referred to as “the guidelines”) have been drafted in accordance with the university’s “Establishment Rules for the Best Project Award.”

Article 2 All students taking the “Special Topics on Industrial Management” course should submit a copy of the practical project report before the final exam date (based on the university calendar) of the first semester of their senior year. This report is sent for review to the preliminary review committee.

Article 3 The department’s full-time faculty members will form the review committee for the preliminary stage.

Article 4 For the finals, representatives from the industry sector, industry faculty members, as well as alumni (a total of three to five members) will make up the finals committee. Each qualifying project group will be required to give a presentation of their work.

Article 5 Scores from the initial and final judging will be tallied and the contestant with the highest average score will be ranked first and given the department’s “Best Practical Project Award.” The awardee will receive their prize from the Office of Academic Affairs, while second and third prizewinners will receive certificates from the department.

Article 6 These guidelines will be implemented after approval during the department affairs meeting, as will all future revisions.
